

REPUBLIC OF NIGER

Children and AIDS Marks Theme of Issue

In this special 1997 Republic of Niger issue, a tribute is paid to the late Princess Diana and one of her selected AIDS Charities, the National AIDS Trust, of Great Britain. The minature sheet contains one semi-postal stamp valued at 1500 F + 250 F and features a photo of Diana speaking at a podium. The surcharge of 250 F is earmarked to the Diana global charity trust set up in her memory.

The Canadian AIDS Society surveyed AIDS groups across the country and have now made plans to tie National AIDS Awareness Week in with World AIDS Day, December 01. Therefore, National AIDS Awareness Week will be November 23 to 30, 1998 this year.

Although the date has been changed, the theme for National AIDS Awareness Week this year remains the same as it was last - "The Changing Face Of AIDS," with a focus on youth, women, IV drug users, and native peoples.


SAN MARINO DECENNIAL

September 19, 1998 marked the 10th anniversary of the world's first AIDS related postage stamp. The Republic of San Marino saw fit to release an issue of 4 stamps (Scott 1187-89) on the occasion of the International AIDS Congress held there in October of 1988.




POSTCARD PURSUIT

Surprisingly, we have not yet seen anything in the way of stamps or cancels coming out of Geneva, Switzerland, relating to the XIIth World AIDS Conference held there June 28 to July 03, 1998.

BELGIUM issued this semi-postal with a surtax of 4 BEF to go directly to the support of the fight against AIDS. The stamp (B1125) was issued 06 November 1995.



DENMARK issued this semi-postal with a surtax of 0.50 DKK was issued on 10 October 1996. The surcharge from this stamp is earmarked for the benefit of The AIDS-Foundation of Denmark.





INDONESIA issued this semi-posytal with a surtax of 100 Rp on December 01, 1997. Again, the is designated for the Indonesian AIDS Foundation.

MACEDONIA issued a set of three Postal Tax Stamps (one single stamp and one S/S perf. and imperf.) obligatory for use December 01 to 07, 1995 for the Red Cross Fund. The design mentions male/female relations and AIDS. Scott RA76-78.



As with the single stamp cover (above) here we illustrate the imperforate souvenir sheet from this issue. The third cover (not shown) is identical to the S/S here, except that it is perforated.
